➤ Poverty in Kenya Begins
With a Lack of Clean Water

➤ More than 1000 die daily in Kenya from unclean water and poor sanitation.





Most susceptible to deadly diarrheal diseases are children

Contaminated water used for personal hygiene causes skin and eye disease



Clean water is distributed to planned urban and wealthy rural communities but people in slums and remote villages (like Katwanyaa) often go without.



Millions of women in Kenya are prohibited from accomplishing little more than surviving because of a lack of clean water and adequate sanitation.



She gathers her family drinking and cooking water where animals had just waded in to drink



If she could get "clean well water" she would pay 5 times what women in **America** would pay



This is typical of water drawn from the Rivers and pools

Girls loose out on an education because of illness or hours spent daily carrying water.

This drives them further into poverty.

They are often subject to sexual attacks as they go for water.




A jerry can of water weighs 40 lb.

• Many suffer years of pain and permanent physical problems from packing these heavy loads Women and children walk an average of 4 miles daily to get water.

During dry seasons they wait hours for water to slowly refill a hole dug in the sand








This is similar to what our finished "WELL" will look like.

There will be a strong stone and steel re-enforced structure which will support a 16,000 liter storage tank and house all of the sensitive hoses and machinery to avoid vandalism OR any ability to contaminate the well.
